- CESSATION OF INCLUSION UNDER THE CPF INVESTMENT SCHEME

We, UOB Asset Management Ltd ("UOBAM"), are the managers of the UniFund (the "Fund"), a Singapore-authorised standalone unit trust that is currently included under the Central Provident Fund ("CPF") Investment Scheme ("CPFIS"), for subscription by members of the public using their CPF monies.

Following an internal re-evaluation of the Fund, we have decided to withdraw the Fund from its continued inclusion under CPFIS with effect from 17 December 2010 (the "Effective Date").

As a result of the aforesaid, the Fund will, with effect from the Effective Date, no longer be managed in accordance with the CPF Investment Guidelines and investors would no longer be able to use their CPF monies to subscribe for new or further units in the Fund (including subscriptions under Regular Savings Plans using CPF monies). However, there will be no change in the investment objective of the Fund and the Fund will continue to be managed in accordance with the same.

The options available to holders who had subscribed for units in the Fund using their CPF monies ("CPF investors") are as follows:

Option 1: CPF investors may choose to continue to hold their units in the Fund. In such an event, no action on their part is required.

Option 2: CPF investors may choose to switch their units in the Fund to units in any CPFIS-included fund managed by UOBAM, at their net asset value per unit, subject to provisions on switching of units in the relevant trust deeds. There will be no switching fee imposed if switching is done within 6 months from the date of this letter, that is, from 1 November 2010 to 29 April 2011 (including both days) (the "Switching Period"). **Any switching of units outside of the Switching Period will be subject to a switching fee of 1%.**

Before deciding to switch units in the Fund for units in any CPFIS-included fund managed by UOBAM, investors should read the relevant prospectus carefully and consult their financial advisers to help them assess the suitability of the fund in accordance with their investment profile. Copies of the prospectuses of CPFIS-included funds managed by UOBAM may be obtained from UOBAM or any of our appointed agents or distributors.

Option 3: CPF investors may realise their outstanding units in the Fund by submitting a completed realisation form to us or our appointed agents or distributors, and any realisation will be subject to the provisions of the trust deed constituting the Fund.

In connection with the above, we will be lodging a supplementary prospectus with the Monetary Authority of Singapore on or around the date of this letter.
